

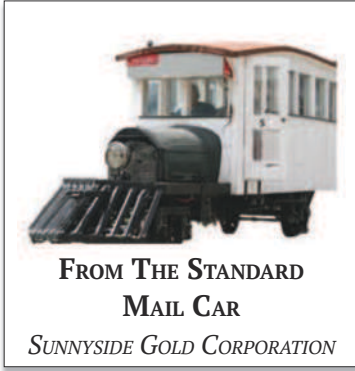

Applauding the Animas River Stakeholders Group

Sunnyside Gold Corporation (SGC) was asked to

speaking at a monument dedication ceremony honoring the Animas River Stakeholders Group (ARSG) on May 7, 2021.
